

A Week In Review

Accomplishments from June 15th to 19th, 2020:

- To date, **172** staff have been mask fitted for N95 masks.
- **1** TDSA organization received an on-site visit with a Medical Microbiologist (MM) / Infectious Disease (ID) Specialist. To date, **9** organizations have received on-site visits with the MM/ID Specialist.
- Pre-visit calls were newly implemented to make the most of the onsite visit. To date **5** organizations had a pre-site call.
- **1** organization received a specialized debriefing session with the MM/ID Specialist. To date, **9** organizations have received specialized debriefing sessions.
- **1** sector-wide “Lessons-Learned” session with the MM/ID Specialist. To date, there have been **6** sector-wide “Lessons-Learned” sessions.
- **5** Learning Modules were offered to TDSA staff, focused on the following topics:
 - Hand Hygiene & Enhanced Screening;
 - Cleaning & Disinfecting of Physical Environment; and
 - Infection Control & Outbreak/Isolation Precautions.
- To date, **43** Learning Modules have been completed with TDSA Staff and **10** staff have completed the Practice Champion Training.

Lessons Learned from our time with a Medical Microbiologist/Infectious Disease Specialist

- Hand hygiene is of the utmost importance and one of your best protections against spreading infection.
- Masks should be worn at all times while working.
- Maintain physical distancing to protect the health of staff and clients as much as possible.
- Ensure that areas are clean and disinfected according to your protocols, especially in shared spaces such as the kitchen.
- Decluttering as much as possible in your physical environments helps facilitate cleaning and disinfection to reduce the risk of cross contamination.

Upcoming for June 22nd to June 26th, 2020:

- 27 N95 mask fittings scheduled.
- 4 Learning Modules scheduled.
- 1 TDSA organization to receive an onsite visit with a MM/ID Specialist, as well as 1 specialized debrief and pre-visit call.
- 1 Sector-wide “lessons learned” session with a MM/ID Specialist.
- 1 Staff Town Hall with a cross sector team with expertise in infectious disease.
