



A Week In Review

Accomplishments from June 1st to 5th, 2020:

- To date, **89** staff have been mask fitted for N95 masks.
- **2** TDSA organizations received an on-site visit with a Medical Microbiologist (MM) / Infectious Disease (ID) Specialist. To date, **7** organizations have received on-site visits with the MM/ID Specialist; this week, pre-site visit calls with the MM/ID Specialist were implemented as well. **3** organizations had a pre-site call.
- **2** organizations have received specialized debriefing sessions with the MM/ID Specialist. To date, **7** organizations have received specialized debriefing sessions.
- **1** sector-wide “Lessons-Learned” session with the MM/ID Specialist. This week, the “Lessons-Learned” session was open to a wider audience, including Managers and Supervisors. To date, there have been **4** sector-wide “Lessons-Learned” sessions.
- **8** Learning Modules were offered to TDSA staff, focused on the following topics:
 - Hand Hygiene & Enhanced Screening;
 - Cleaning & Disinfecting of Physical Environment; and
 - Infection Control & Outbreak/Isolation Precautions.
- To date, **35** Learning Modules have been offered to TDSA Staff and **3** staff have completed the Practice Champion Training.

Lessons Learned from our time with a Medical Microbiologist/Infectious Disease Specialist

- Hand hygiene is of the utmost importance and one of your best protections against spreading infection.
- Masks should be worn at all times while working.
- Maintain physical distancing to protect the health of staff and clients as much as possible.
- Ensure that areas are clean and disinfected according to your protocols, especially in shared spaces such as the kitchen.
- Decluttering as much as possible in your physical environments helps facilitate cleaning and disinfection to reduce the risk of cross contamination.
